

Information for Newly Admitted Students

for Fall 2009 International Admission

1. Tuition Payment

- Payment Period (Undergraduate transfer, Graduate students) : **24th Aug. ~ 28th Aug. 2009**
- Printing Tuition Bill: Information regarding printing one's tuition bill will be announced on the Office of Admissions website (<http://admission.snu.ac.kr>). Students must make the full payment according to the payment instructions within the announced payment period to be enrolled for the term. Enrollment after the payment period will not be allowed.
- Please make remittances via home banks: Nong Hyup bank or SHINHAN bank (tentative)

2. Korean Language Proficiency Test

- Test Subjects (한국어능력측정대상) : Only applicable to designated students who are notified to sit for the Korean Proficiency Test when you check the result through website. After testing, they will be allowed to enroll in Degree Program if test scores indicate college-level placement.
 - Test Date: **25th Aug. 2009 at 14:00**
 - Test Location: Language Education Institute (Bldg #137-1, Tel. +82 2 880 5488)
 - Test Fee: **15,000 Korean Won** (Please pay the test fee to the registrar in Room 101 at LEI BEFORE taking the test. For a more detailed information, please refer to SNU Language Institute's website) <http://language.snu.ac.kr>
 - Must bring official identification (**Passport** recommended)
 - Announcement of Test Result : Beginning of September 2009 at their respective department administration offices.
- ※ Students with an insufficient Korean language proficiency will be required to take a Korean language course at SNU Language institute, and course selection will be restricted. Whether the said restrictions would be applied is decided based on the discretion of their respective departments.

3. Accommodation

- If you apply for university housing, you will be on the dormitory waiting list. Please apply between **6th July 2009 ~ 10th July**. For details, please refer to the website : <http://dorm.snu.ac.kr>

4. How to obtain a Visa

- Certificates of Admission for admitted students will be mailed to the applicants **from 6th July 2009**. If you want to retrieve the Certificate of Admission in person, you may visit the Office of International Affairs (OIA +82 2 880 8635, Bldg # 152). If you want to change the mailing address, please make sure to contact the office of international affairs at pinesjh@snu.ac.kr (The title of the email : Certificate of Admission)
- After you receive the certificate of admission, you need to apply for D-2 visa.
 - Inside Korea : Please visit the Immigration office to apply for D-2 visa
 - Outside Korea : Please visit the Embassies or Consulates of Korea to apply for D-2 visa
 - * Other forms will be mailed to Chinese applicants outside Korea due to specific procedures.
- Students who already have a visa have to get permission from Immigration office to go side by side study. (except D1, D5, D9, E1, E7, F1, F2, F3, F4, F5, H2 visa)

- The applicant who has submitted the photocopy should submit the original document **by 28th Aug. 2009**. If the applicant does not do it, her/his admission permit is cancelled.
